Applications

- New
- Transitional
- Variations
- Transfers
- Renewals (SI 2012 No 2111)
- Temporary Exemption Notices







Process – **stages**:

- 1 Enquiry (information and advice)
- (2) Application submitted and acknowledged
- (3) Visits?
- 4 Draft licence issued and representations
- 5 Licence proper issued
- 6 Appeal to Tribunal
- (7) Follow up on conditions etc.







Some of the issues

- Information sought at application
- Application on-line or written
- Data handling and security etc (GDPR)
- Workloads and service planning
- Expectations e.g. response times etc.





Some more of the issues

- Fees are for a service
- The pricing structure should provide incentives
- Conditions and expiry date (local schemes)
- Visits
- Undersize rooms evictions?
